



CALL FOR WORKING PAPERS

The **Greek Politics Specialist Group (GPSG)** of the Political Studies Association (PSA) invites submissions for its Working Paper series published on the GPSG website (www.gpsg.org.uk). We welcome scholarly contributions on all fields and topics of Greek political and social studies. Interdisciplinary, comparative and innovative approaches are particularly welcome.

All types of scholarly papers can be submitted, including literature reviews, conceptual papers, interim reports, research agendas, methodological critiques or full papers featuring primary research. Papers submitted go through a peer review aiming to provide authors with constructive feedback, as well as ensure that published papers meet certain standards of coherence, structure and argumentation.

Editorial Guidelines:

- ❖ We only accept papers written in the English language. Papers should be carefully proof-read before being submitted as our reviewers and editorial team will not accept or revise poorly written manuscripts.
- ❖ While there is no strict word limit, papers should not exceed 7,000 words. Shorter contributions are also welcome.
- ❖ Manuscripts should be single-spaced, using Arial font size 12.
- ❖ The Harvard referencing system should be followed consistently throughout the document. References should appear on an alphabetical list at the end of the document rather than in footnotes or endnotes.
- ❖ A short abstract, author bio and full contact details should be included.
- ❖ While copyright remains with the authors (unless a Creative Commons licence is chosen), the GPSG reserves the right to publish, archive and reproduce working papers.
