We invite submissions on any aspect of Greek society, government, policies or politics. Emphasis will be placed on innovation, excellence, engagement and impact - whether through an innovative research design, methodology or technique; advanced thinking and scholarship; ground-breaking argumentation; or impact on academia, politics and communities.

Papers can be of a scholarly, conceptual, experimental, comparative, investigative, applied or even practical nature, including research proposals, interim reports, work in progress and preliminary findings, as long as they feature a robust rationale, clear objectives and appropriate outputs that advance our understanding or engagement with Greek society and politics.

A panel of judges will award three prizes (€300, €200, €100) and the winning papers will be published as part of the GPSG Working Paper Series (<http://www.gpsg.org.uk/publications/working-papers/>).
