In this research note, Dr Vasilaki outlines the background, aims, research questions and research design of a very exciting project looking at an under-researched topic from a novel angle. The paper won the 2nd prize at last year's GPSG Competition "Innovative Approaches to the Study of Greek Society and Politics".
